Section 1 General Rules and Regulations

- 1.1 Power to set Fees.** The fees and charges for all programs and activities of Shawnee County Parks & Recreation shall be those fees and charges, which are prescribed by the Director of Shawnee County Parks & Recreation.
- 1.2 Fees subject to change.** The following lists of fees are current in reference to the facilities and activities as identified. These fees are subject to change as directed by either the Board of Shawnee County Commissioners or the Director of Parks & Recreation.
- 1.3 Service Charge assessed for returned checks.** A service charge Thirty Dollars (\$30) shall be assessed against any person who makes a check payable to Shawnee County or to any official or department of Shawnee County if said check is returned unpaid to Shawnee County by the bank upon which it is drawn for any reason.
- 1.4 Fees are non-refundable.** All fees charged by Shawnee County Parks & Recreation are non-refundable subject to the exceptions stated in section 1.5 of this document, which prescribes the rules and regulations in force within the facilities and parks of Parks & Recreation. Fees may also be refunded when the Director of Parks & Recreation authorizes such action in writing.
- 1.5 Refunds to participants in programs, classes, trips, leagues**
- 1.5.a Full refunds will be issued for classes cancelled by Shawnee County Parks & Recreation or if the participant notifies the department prior to the start of the program.
- 1.5.b No program refunds will be issued for any reason from the halfway point of a class session to conclusion.
- 1.5.c Pro-rated refunds will be issued after the class has begun for the following reasons:
Moving outside Shawnee County,
Illness (provide doctor's excuse), or
Class is unsatisfactory to participant.
- 1.5.d Trip refunds will be issued in full if:
Replacement can be found or trip costs can be recovered, or for
Personal or family medical reasons.
- 1.5.e Athletic refunds will be issued in full if the Athletic Office is notified at least twenty-one (21) calendar days prior to the initial start date of the league. Refunds after this time will be issued with a 40% of fee service charge.
- 1.5.f Shelter refunds will be given only when:
Partial refunds with a 10% of fee service charge will be given for cancellations received at least fourteen (14) calendar days prior to reservation date,
No refunds will be given for cancellations received less than fourteen (14) calendar days prior to reservation date,
Requests for shelter refunds from individuals who reserved and used a shelter are required to be in writing and addressed to the Director of Parks & Recreation. The Director or their designee will check to see if the Facility Acceptance form was signed upon check-in; the Ranger's log sheets; park crew/technician's logs to determine if refund is justified.
- 1.6 Group Rates.** The Director of Parks & Recreation shall have the authority to prescribe special fees for activities that require payment of a fee or authorize extended activity time to organizations or groups that participate in such activities as a group. Determination of eligibility of a group for such group rates or privileges shall be made at the discretion of the Director of Parks & Recreation.

Section 3

Use, Licensing, Operation and Equipment of Boating and Skiing on Lake Shawnee

3.1 BOATING AND SKIING

In 2005, the Board of County Commissioners for Shawnee County entered into an agreement with the Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks. In an effort to reduce barriers to boating and fishing, KDWP using federal funds from the U.S. Sportfish Restoration Act, leased the fishing and boating rights from Shawnee County. During the period of this agreement neither the purchase nor the possession of Lake Shawnee Boat licenses will be required. This agreement between Shawnee County and KDWP is an annual agreement and can be terminated with thirty (30) days notice. The reinstatement of Lake Shawnee Boat licenses would become effective immediately upon the termination of the agreement. The possession of valid State licenses and permits are still required.

- 3.1 Season permit per boat - \$50.
- 3.2 Daily permit per boat - \$20.
- 3.3 Purchasing a season or daily boat permit from a Park Police Officer while boating without a license - \$10 service charge.
- 3.4 Permit decal replacement per set, per boat - \$5.
- 3.5 Removal and towing of abandoned boat – \$100.
- 3.6 Storage of abandoned boat per day - \$5.
- 3.7 Season permit for boat dealers - \$100.
- 3.8 Marina Rentals – Pedal boat, canoe, row boat rental fees per boat each one-half (1/2) hour - \$3.

Fishing at Lake Shawnee

4. FISHING

In 2005, the Board of County Commissioners for Shawnee County entered into an agreement with the Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks. In an effort to reduce barriers to boating and fishing, KDWP using federal funds from the U.S. Sportfish Restoration Act, leased the fishing rights from Shawnee County. During the period of this agreement neither the purchase nor the possession of Lake Shawnee Fishing licenses will be required. This agreement between Shawnee County and KDWP is an annual agreement and can be terminated with thirty (30) days notice. The reinstatement of Lake Shawnee Fishing licenses would become effective immediately upon the termination of the agreement.

In 2007, the Board of County Commissioners for Shawnee County entered into an amendment to the agreement with the KDWP to include Trout Fishing Rights. During the period of this agreement neither the purchase nor the possession of Lake Shawnee Fishing or Trout licenses will be required.

The possession of valid State of Kansas licenses and permits are still required.

- 4.1 Shawnee County Fishing License per year - \$15.
- 4.2 Shawnee County Trout permit per year - \$15.
- 4.3 Purchasing a Shawnee County Fishing License and/or Shawnee County Trout Permit and/or State of Kansas Fishing License from a Park Police Officer while fishing without a license - \$10 service charge per license.

Section 5
Camping at Lake Shawnee

5.1 LAKE SHAWNEE CAMPGROUND

5.1.a All camping units between the inclusive date of April 15 and October 15 per camping unit per day - \$18.

5.1.b All camping units between the inclusive date of October 16 and April 14 per camping unit per day - \$15.

5.2 All persons sixty-two (62) years of age and older shall receive a discount of \$1 off the daily base rate.

5.3 Dump station fee for non-campground use - \$5.

5.4 Tents erected with an R.V. in the same site will be charged an additional \$5 per tent site per day.

5.5 Visitor Car Pass only vehicles displaying Visitor Car Pass will be allowed inside gate, all other vehicles must park outside campground - \$5

11.a LAKE SHAWNEE GOLF COURSE

11.a.1 Annual Fee Structure: Annual fee entitles holder to play both Lake Shawnee and Forbes Golf Courses. Lake Shawnee Golf Course will sell a maximum of 225 annual passes.

11.a.1.a **Junior** - Seventeen (17) years of age and younger.

Single - \$210

11.a.1.b **Adult** - Eighteen (18) years of age through sixty-one (61) years of age.

Joint (husband and wife) - \$1120

11.a.1.c **Senior** - Sixty-two (62) years of age through seventy-four (74) years of age.

Single - \$700

Joint (husband and wife) - \$995

11.a.2 “Grand fathered” Fee Structure: Includes golfers who have purchased continuous annual permits since 1997. The goal for this category of golfer is for golfers to be entitled to a 5% discount off the above annual fee structure. All grand fathered fees will increase by 7% in 2008 or less if the 5% discount off the above annual fee structure is attained. These fees will be rounded up to the nearest five-dollar (\$5.00) increment. Annual fee entitles the holder to play both Lake Shawnee and Forbes Golf Courses.

11.a.3 “Super Senior”: Golfers are eligible on their 75th birthday.

11.a.4 NEW “Senior Weekday Only” Fee Structure: This annual fee entitles holder Sixty-two (62) years of age and older to play any Monday through Friday, except for holidays and tournaments.
